### National Finals Show

Our season has kicked off well. As a council we are always striving to do the best for cutting in NZ. With our two major shows just around the corner, we are looking into getting an Australian judge for the National Finals. The cost to do so is similar to bringing one over for the futurity approximately \$1400. We as an association cannot afford to take this extra money out of our main accounts as it already provides the \$1500 towards the purse. There are two ways round this.

1. We charge a separate fee on top of your total entry fees. With the calculations that have been done with probable contestants entering, the cost is approximately \$70 per person entered.
2. Or if the members can find sponsorship for either the purses or for judges costs then this cost to entrants could be reduced. The pre-budget for the National finals predicts that without an Australian judge the National Finals will run at a \$709 loss or with an Australian Judge with competitor fee of \$70 the show will still run at a loss of \$600.

Have a think about our options and get back to Karen Matchitt [bonus3@xtra.co.nz](mailto:bonus3@xtra.co.nz) with your ideas and feedback, council are having a brief meeting to finalise arrangements after the Saturday show at Mackies on 20<sup>th</sup> Feb.

The venue for the Nationals is still being confirmed, however we can say they will not be at

Te Uranga B2 Inc, Taumaranui. At this stage Jack who was the manager at Te Uranga B2 is now managing Te Pa Station, near Waiouru and he is very happy to have us there for the Nationals, so we are just waiting for approval from the Atihau-Whanganui Incorporation before we go ahead with the show approval.

Could all of last year trophy winners please ensure the trophies are engraved and returned in clean condition, thank you?
